Demographic Data

The current population of Georgia is 3 718 200 as of 2017. The Georgian healthcare system incorporates both public and private healthcare services. National public health system services are available to specific groups of Georgian residents. Georgia currently spends around 2.5% of its Gross Domestic Product (GDP) on healthcare. Around 45% is public expenditure and 55% is private expenditure.

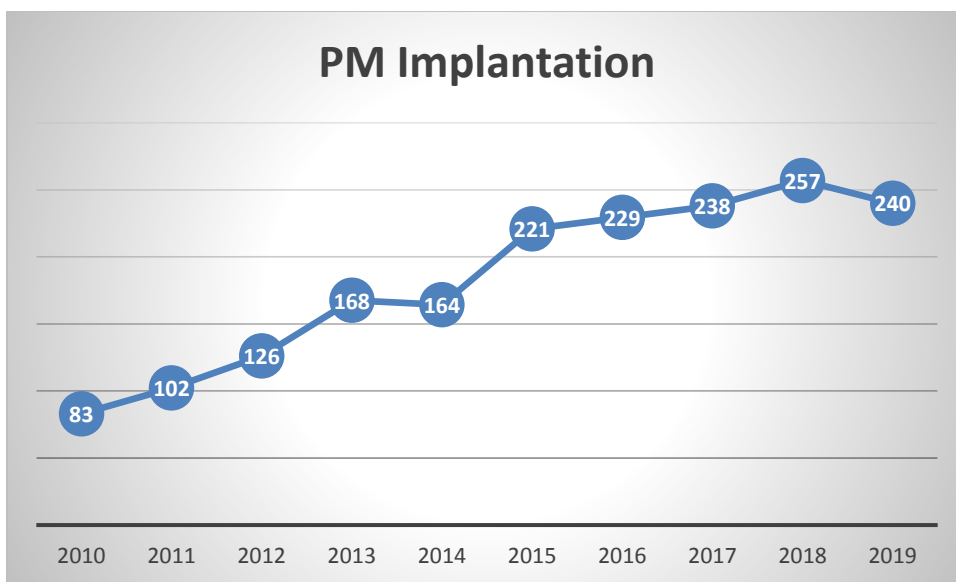
Training in Rhythmology

In Georgia, the training in Electrophysiology lasts two years after the completion of the Fellowship in General Cardiology. The trainees undertake simultaneous training in both Cardiovascular Electrophysiology and Cardiovascular Implantable Electronic Device (CIED) therapy. The final assessment consists of a curricular evaluation and a written examination, after which the cardiologist is certified as a specialist in Arrhythmia management and Cardiac Electrophysiology.

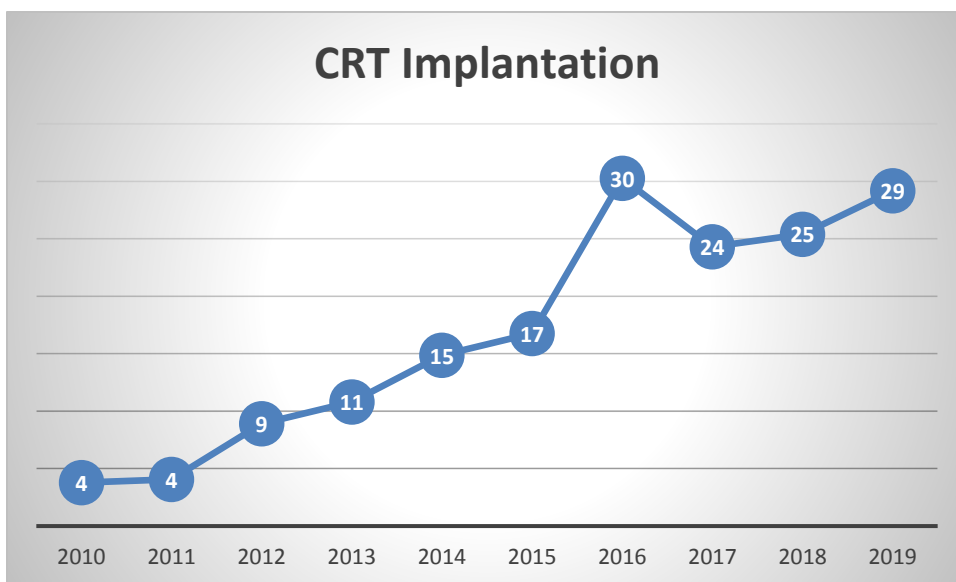

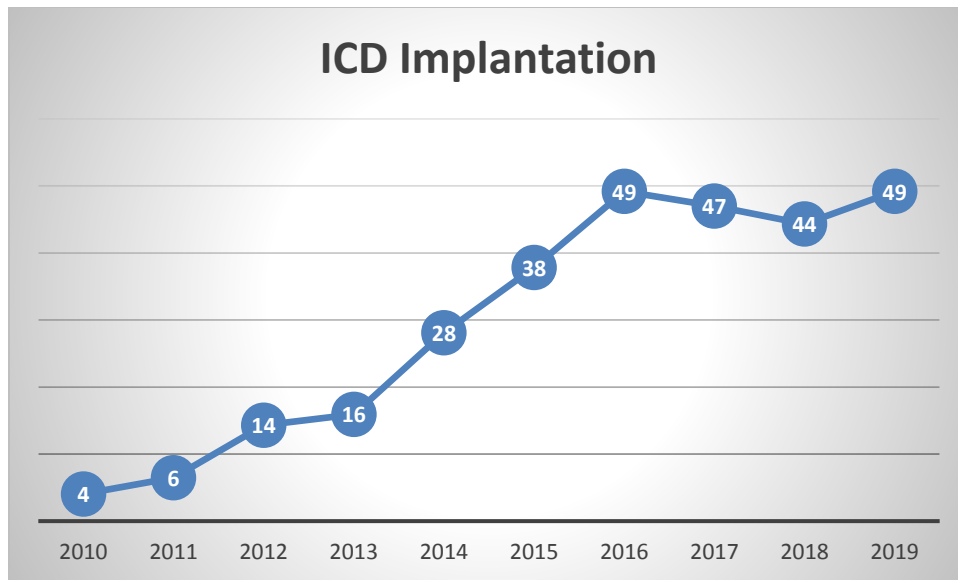
- GeHRA PM Implantations per 1 million population



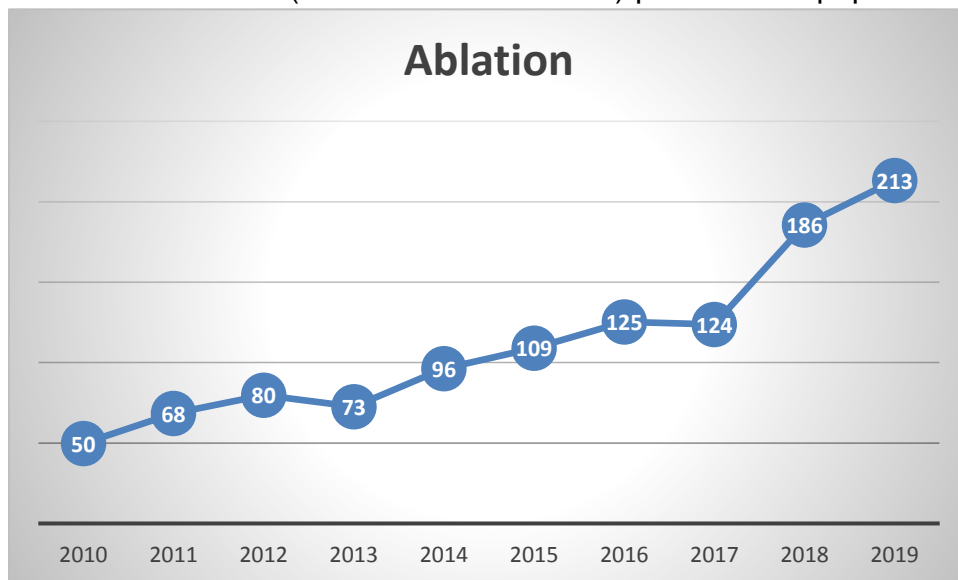
- GeHRA CRT Implantations per 1 million population



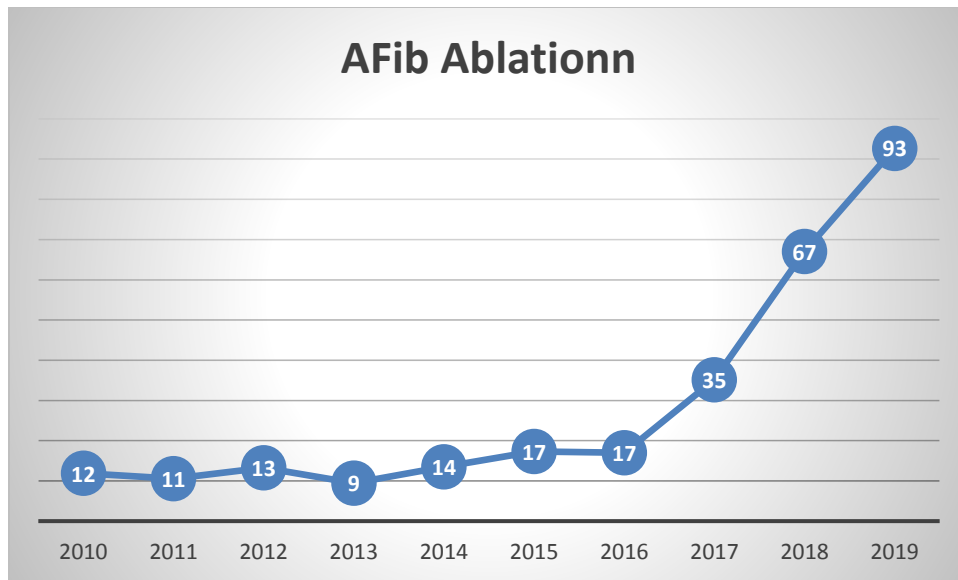
- GeHRA ICD Implantations per 1 million population
